The description of the creation gives us an opportunity to learn more about adjectives. Did you notice when we read this story that the different objects in the creation are described. When you read about the grass and flowers in the first paragraph, you will find more words to describe the grass and flowers.

We see the green grass and the beautiful flowers.

The words green and beautiful are adjectives. You will find lots of adjectives in this lesson. Look for the nouns or objects in the creation and then look for a word that describes that noun. Write the adjective and the noun that is being described on the lines below.

Example:	Green grass	beautiful flowers
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Overused Adjectives: Some adjectives are used too often and can make your writing dull. Writing is improved when you can find alternatives for overused adjectives. Some of the overused adjectives include good, nice, and pretty. Look at your list of adjectives that you wrote down. Will any of these adjectives make a better alternative for the words good, pretty, and nice?
