## Proverbs from the Bible

## **Proverbs 3: 21-25**

- 21 ¶ My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion:
- 22 So shall they be life unto thy soul, and grace to thy neck.
- 23 Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble.
- 24 When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.
- 25 Be not afraid of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when it cometh.

## **Proverbs 4: 7-13**

- 7 <sup>a</sup>Wisdom *is* the principal thing; *therefore* get wisdom: and with all thy getting get <sup>b</sup>understanding.
- 8 Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour, when thou dost embrace her.
- 9 She shall give to thine head an <sup>a</sup>ornament of grace: a crown of <sup>b</sup>glory shall she deliver to thee.
- 10 Hear, O my son, and receive my sayings; and the  $^a$ years of thy life shall be many.
- 11 I have taught thee in the way of wisdom; I have  $^{a}$ led thee in right paths.
- **12** When thou goest, thy steps shall not be <sup>a</sup>straitened; and when thou <sup>b</sup>runnest, thou shalt not stumble.
- **13** Take fast <sup>a</sup>hold of <sup>b</sup>instruction; let *her* not go: keep her; for she *is* thy life.
